UC Davis Jazz Band Revisits Tradition at Mondavi Center

Davis, Calif.—The **UC Davis Jazz Band**, aka **Wednesday Night Big Band**, along with the band’s **Jazz Improv** combo, performs at **8 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 14**, in the **Studio Theatre of Mondavi Center for the Performing Arts**. This is the group’s debut with **Delbert Bump**, new director and instructor of jazz ensembles at UC Davis, outstanding jazz organist, multi-genre composer, and professor at Solano Community College. The program, **“The Tradition Revisited,”** includes big band arrangements of works by **Herbie Hancock, George Gershwin, Manning Sherwin, Denis DiBlasio, Miles Davis, and Cole Porter**, while the combo repertoire includes **Kenny Baron’s “Voyage”** and **Delbert Bump’s own “Reflex.”**
